Level 1

Overview

This established programme is endorsed by the Pro-Vice-Chancellor. It explores the complex leadership skills required by aspiring Heads of Institution and those in equivalent roles, in support of the University's mission of achieving world-class research and teaching.

The Senior Leadership Programme Level 1 aims to provide better understanding about the role of Head of Institution, as well as an opportunity for aspiring leaders to connect, discuss current challenges and learn from experiences.

The programme provides a chance to meet our Pro-Vice-Chancellor for University Community and Engagement Professor Munir as well as current and past Heads of Institutions.

Participants are encouraged to network and actively participate in discussions as well as share their own experiences.

Duration

One whole day and four half day sessions across four months, plus optional virtual leadership briefing series covering a range of topics.

Live in-person.

- Aspiring Heads of Institution and equivalent, academic and professional services staff.
- Grades 10 to 12.

By the end of the programme you will be able to:

- Understand better the role of Head of Institution/ Head of Function/ Head of Department.
- Identify the challenges of the role and the skills required.
- Develop a good understanding about inclusive culture, inclusive leadership and decision making.
- Understand your own Inclusive Leadership profile based on a 360 feedback assessment.
- Prepare for managing challenging people matters effectively.
- Understand more about the role of Hol in leading change in the institution.
- Build your confidence, accelerate and deepen your own learning with the development of your own Individual development plan.
- Network and share knowledge and expertise with other aspiring future leaders of the institution.



Programme content

Day 1: Leadership and understanding the role of Head of Institution in the context of the university

Welcome and introduction from the Pro-Vice-Chancellor and guest speakers.

Day 2: Inclusive culture, inclusive leadership and decision making

Leadership theories, 360 feedback and interactive workshop delivered by Pearn Kandola.

Day 3: The role of Head of Institution in leading change

Hear experiences of other Hols in leading change in the institution.

Day 4: Dealing with challenging people situations and developing an individual development plan

Get insight on how to effectively manage people matters, collaborate and discuss real case scenarios and start working on a development plan.

Day 5: Panel discussion with past SLP participants and networking

Panel discussion with other Hols who are alumni of the Senior Leadership Programme, an interactive discussion and lessons learnt session with the PVC and an opportunity to network.
